



## **SOUTHSIDE OPPORTUNITY FUND APPLICATION PROCESS**

**Application Deadline: March 29, 2019**

STEP 1: Complete the Southside Opportunity Fund Application. Failure to provide the requested information may result in disqualification. Submit the application and all supporting documents electronically by email to [public.relations@sec.coop](mailto:public.relations@sec.coop) no later than March 29, 2019.

STEP 2: Compile all the documents listed below. Attach documents as PDF files to email along with completed application. If you are mailing, do not staple, paper clip, insert into binders or fold. Do not send any of these documents separately, except where noted. Seal all documents in one envelope in the following sequence (from front to back):

1. Copy of most recent SEC electric bill.
2. Personal Statement. It must be a one-page, typed and double-spaced document with your full name in the upper right-hand corner. The Southside Opportunity Fund Board will score the statements based on the following: how compelling your statement is about why you should be selected to receive a scholarship, your financial need, your involvement in school and community activities, your family dynamics, and how well you follow directions. Points will be deducted if you include a resume, profile of extracurricular activities, certificates or other personal records.
3. Copy of preliminary high or home school transcript.
4. Copy of Standardized Test Scores (SAT and/or ACT).
5. Recommendation letter written by someone not related to applicant.

Postmarked no later than midnight on March 29, 2019 or hand-delivered no later than 5:00 p.m. on March 29, 2019.

In May, award notifications are emailed to applicants who have been selected to receive a scholarship. **If chosen, you will be required to provide your college student ID#, your acceptance letter from the college or technical/trade school, and the name and mailing address of the department (Financial Aid, Registrar's Office, etc.) that should receive your scholarship check. Funds will not be dispersed until this information is received.**

## **SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION**

The Southside Opportunity Fund awards \$1,000 scholarships annually to high school students across our 18-county service territory. A combination of weighted criteria is used in the selection process: 45% financial need, 45% academic achievement and 10% personal statement. Funds must be applied towards tuition, student fees, room and board or textbooks.

### **ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS**

1. Applicant's primary residence must receive its electric power from Southside Electric Cooperative.
2. Applicant must be a high or home school senior graduating in 2019.
3. Applicant must be entering his or her first semester at a college or technical/trade school in the fall of 2019. Proof of admission will be required if selected to receive a scholarship.
